

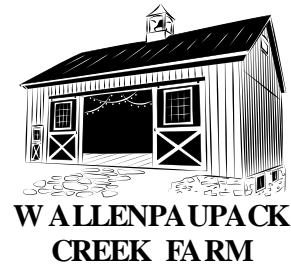

### Detail of Rental

- 3 day only rental of property/farm (typically Friday-Sunday)
  - o Use includes options of: Friday rehearsal dinner and/or set-up, Saturday ceremony and reception, Sunday breakfast and/or clean-up
- 3 options for ceremony locations:
  - o Inside barn overlooking pastures
  - o Creekside campsite (along the east branch of the Wallenpaupack Creek)
  - o Pasture
- Includes use of:
  - o 16 handmade 9 foot cherry tables sourced from local trees
  - o 200 foldable antique wooden chairs
  - o Option to use rustic decorations and serving ware (platters, mason jars, vases, chargers, large bowls, burlap runners, table numbers, cloth napkins etc...)
  - o 6 handmade hightop cocktail cherry tables
  - o 2 rustic handmade bar stations
  - o Bathroom trailer (includes flushing toilets and running water, climate control)
  - o Shuttle around farm as needed via side-by-side/haywagon

- 40 acre farm property in South Sterling, PA
- 2 hours drive west of NYC and 2 hours drive north of Philadelphia
- Barn
  - o 54x40 open floor plan – well suited for a reception
  - o Max capacity of 200 people
  - o Grand double barn door entrance
  - o Back grand double barn door balcony overlooking cow pasture
  - o Bell tower with operational 175 year old bell
  - o Originally built in 1839 by German settlers
  - o Reconstructed in 2017 by local Amish builders

  - o Gravel parking area with staff to facilitate parking arrangements
- Courtyard
  - o Space available for: bonfire, cocktail hour, lawn games
